Throughout Sixth Form, students are expected to participate fully in our Enrichment Programme. Outside their core curriculum, they must gain experience in the following areas:

- **Personal Development**
- **Volunteering**
- **Work Experience**

As they progress through Sixth Form, they build an online portfolio that they can incorporate into their personal statement on their university or apprenticeship application.

Some activities, such as lower school student support, take place during the school day; others are organised after school, at weekends or during the school holidays. All students must be fully involved in the Enrichment Programme on a Wednesday afternoon. Through this they develop a broad range of skills, attitudes and behaviours, such as confidence, resilience, organisation and time management, to help them succeed in life beyond school.

There are a number of exciting optional trips organised for Sixth Formers. In recent years these have included a conservation project in South Africa and World Challenge to Cambodia and Vietnam. Our experienced tutor team delivers a programme of pastoral support and personal development through which students are encouraged to reflect on the skills and experiences they are gaining.
