

Minimum Entry Requirements for Sixth Form Courses, 2017

Applied Science	Grade C at GCSE in two or more sciences and Grade 5 in both Maths and English
Art, Craft & Design	Grade B in GCSE Art and Grade 5 in English Language
Biology	Grade B in Core and Additional Science or Biology GCSE including a B grade score on the B1 and B2 GCSE higher theory paper and Grade 5 in both GCSE Maths and English Language
Business	Grade B in GCSE Business Studies, if studied, and Grade 5 in both GCSE Maths and English Language
Chemistry	Grade B in Core Science and Additional Science or Chemistry GCSE including a B grade score on the C1 and C2 GCSE higher theory paper and Grade 5 in GCSE Maths
Computer Science	Grade B in Computer Science at GCSE if studied, and Grade 5 in GCSE Maths; or Grade 6 in GCSE Maths
Design and Technology	Grade B at GCSE in Resistant Materials, Graphic Products, Electronic Products, Design Technology if studied; if not, a grade B in another practical, design-related subject is desirable; Grade 5 in English Language
Drama & Theatre Studies	Grade B in Performing Arts/Drama at GCSE if studied, or a grade 6 in English Literature if Drama was not taken at GCSE; Grade 5 in English Language
English Language	Grade 6 in English Language and Grade 5 in English Literature
English Language & Literature	One Grade 6 and one Grade 5 from English Language and English Literature
English Literature	Grade 6 at GCSE in English Literature and Grade 5 in English Language
French	Grade B in GCSE French and Grade 5 in GCSE English Language
German	Grade B in GCSE German and Grade 5 in English Language
Geography	Grade B in GCSE Geography if studied; if not, Grade 6 in English Language; Grade 5s in GCSE English Language and Maths
Health & Social Care	Grade B in Health and Social Care at GCSE if studied and Grade 5 in GCSE English Language
History	Grade B in GCSE History if studied; if not, Grade 6 in either GCSE English Language or English Literature; and a minimum of Grade 5 in English Language
IT	One Grade 5 and one Grade 4 from GCSE English Language and GCSE Maths
Mathematics	Grade 7 in GCSE Maths is desirable; if a student achieves Grade 6 , entry will be subject to passing an extra test set by school in September
Further Mathematics 2 A Levels – takes 2 blocks	Grade 8 in GCSE Maths is desirable; students with a strong Grade 7 may be considered; students who take Further Maths must choose two other subjects to study at A Level/Level 3
Music	Grade B in GCSE Music; students without GCSE Music may be considered with an audition if they have achieved Grade 5 in a musical instrument/voice and Grade 5 Theory; Grade 5 in English Language
Physical Education	Grade B in GCSE PE if studied; Grade B in Core and Additional Science; if you studied single sciences, Grade B in Biology and Grade C in Chemistry and Physics; Grade 5 in English Language
Physics	Grade B in Core Science and Additional Science or Physics GCSE including a B grade score on the P1 and P2 GCSE higher theory paper; Grade 6 in GCSE Maths
Psychology	Grade 6 in GCSE English Language and grade B in two GCSE sciences; Grade 5 in GCSE Mathematics preferred
Religious Studies	Grade B at GCSE in Religious Studies if studied; if not, Grade 6 in either GCSE English Language or English Literature; a minimum of Grade 5 in English Language
Spanish	Grade B in Spanish at GCSE and Grade 5 in English Language
