- **Outline your future plans after Sixth Form.**
 - For example university, apprenticeship, employment, possible career choice, other courses
- **What do you consider are your strengths and weaknesses in your attitude and approach to learning?**
 - Try to reflect carefully on your attributes and consider how they will support you in being successful.
- **What targets have you set yourself for Year 11 and beyond into Sixth Form?**
 - These can be specific or general, but they will provide evidence of future aspirations
