We are proud of our school's academic record.

We have had another excellent year of results, but given the issues around this summer's examination results, our GCSE headline figures below are based on the last set of formal summer examinations (2019).

We are the highest ranked school in Cumbria for the progress made by our GCSE students.

The progress made by our GCSE students is in the top 10% of all schools nationally.

1 in 5 students achieved eight or more grades 7, 8 and 9.

The proportion of students gaining grades 7, 8 and 9 in English and maths is double the national average.

Over 80% of students obtained both English and maths at grade 4+.

76% of GCSE students achieved five or more grades at 9 - 4 including English and maths.

For students of all abilities, GCSE results are over a third higher than Cumbrian and national figures.

Our high ability maths students achieved progress placing us in the top 1% of all schools nationally.
